ACCEPTANCE REQUIREMENTS

Successful candidates for acceptance in this doctoral program will be:

a) Holders a master's degree or legal equivalent;

b) Holders of a *licenciatura*/bachelor's degree with a relevant academic or scientific curriculum recognized by the program's Scientific Committee as enabling them to attend this cycle of studies;
c) Owners of an academic, scientific or professional curriculum recognized by the Scientific Committee as enabling them to attend this cycle of studies.

The program's Scientific Committee will assess the relevance of the academic and professional curricula and verify whether the educational background is appropriate to attend a doctoral program in Engineering.

RANKING CRITERIA

The ranking of the candidates will be performed by the program's Scientific Committee, taking in consideration:

- the value and relevance of the academic curriculum and professional experience;
- the motivation for attending this doctoral programme.

The following items will be taken in consideration:

- 1. GRE Graduate Record Examinations (http://www.ets.org/gre/).
- 2. TOEFL Test of English as a Foreign Language (http://www.ets.org/).
- 3. Final marks obtained in study programs and degrees held by the candidate. Individual final marks relative to 1st and 2nd cycles will be weighted by the number of years in each cycle when computing the final mark.
- 4. Candidates whose final mark, computed as above, is below 14/20 will be considered only if relevant curricular information is available, e.g. the explicit support of a professor of FEUP.
- 5. Motivation statement.
- 6. Curriculum Vitae of the candidate.
- 7. Recommendation letters.

The candidates may be subject to an interview, should the Scientific Committee find it necessary.

- 1. GRE Test Results Certificate.
- 2. TOEFL Test Results Certificate.
- 3. Certified transcripts of grades obtained in all courses and of final marks in degrees held by the candidate.
- 4. Motivation statement.
- 5. Curriculum Vitae of the candidate.
- 6. At least two recommendation letters should be sent directly by electronic means by the persons who write them to pdeec@fe.up.pt.
